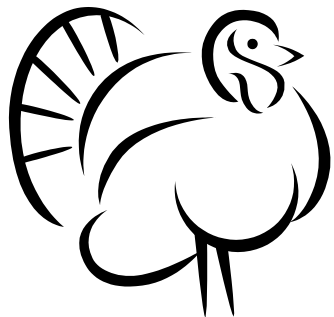

A Little History On Stirling Lodge

Stirling Lodge has been a fishing resort for over 100 years. The Lodge has changed greatly from its beginnings as the home of Col. John Kilborn in the 1830's. The dining room you are now seated in was his private residence. Col. Kilborn served extensively in the war of 1812 between Canada and the United States. After the war, the idea of building the Rideau Canal was considered. In the event of further dissension between the two countries, the canal would serve to by-pass the important stretch of the St. Lawrence River between Montreal and Kingston. The Rideau Canal, was completed in 1832, allowing water traffic to flow from Kingston to Montreal via Ottawa.. As trade flourished in the Newboro area, the original Kilborn Home was converted into a two-storey hotel around the early 1850's. A stone addition was added in the late 1800's to accommodate the expanding population and named the "Rideau Hotel".

The name "Rideau Hotel" was changed to Stirling Lodge when the Stirling family purchased the hotel in the late 1940's. The Stirlings ran the hotel until the Hill family purchased it in 1976. We hope you enjoyed your time here and invite you to visit us again!
